Creating an Image Map In Adobe PageMill

With Adobe PageMill, you can create hyperlinks based on text elements of your Web page. You can also use images that are divided into several sections, with each acting as a hyperlink to a different location on the Internet. This Step-by-Step Card shows you how to create hot spots on your images.

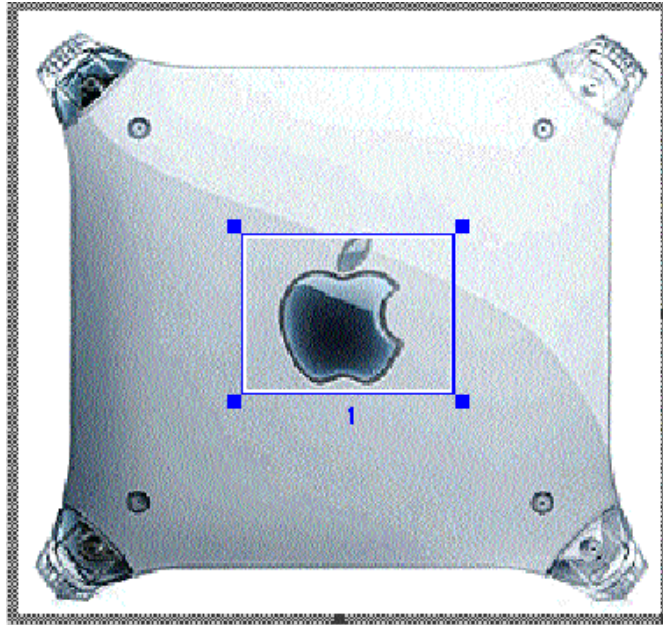
Opening Adobe PageMill

- 1** Open the Adobe PageMill 3.0 application.
- 2** Choose Object from the Insert menu, then choose Image from the submenu.
- 3** Locate and select the image that you would like to insert, then click Insert.

Creating hot spots

- 1** Double-click your image to edit it.
- 2** To add a hot spot, choose Image from the Edit menu, then choose Rectangle Hotspot, Circle Hotspot, or Polygon Hotspot from the submenu.

- 3** Draw the hotspot on your image.



- 4** To make the hotspot a hyperlink, choose Make Link from the Edit menu.
- 5** Enter the address of the page that you want to link to, then click Make WWW Link if the page is on the Internet, or click Link To if the page is locally stored.
- 6** Create additional hot spots, circular or rectangular, and enter the link locations using the Make Link feature.
- 7** Choose Save Page from the File menu.
- 8** When you're done, quit Adobe PageMill.
