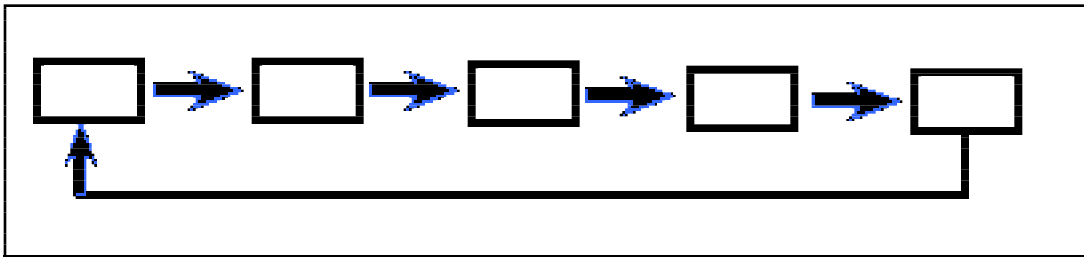


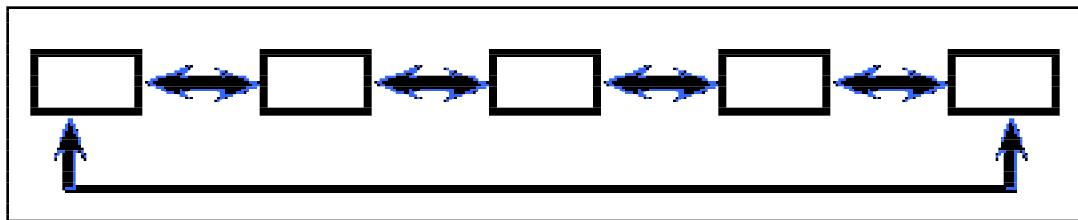

Straight Line



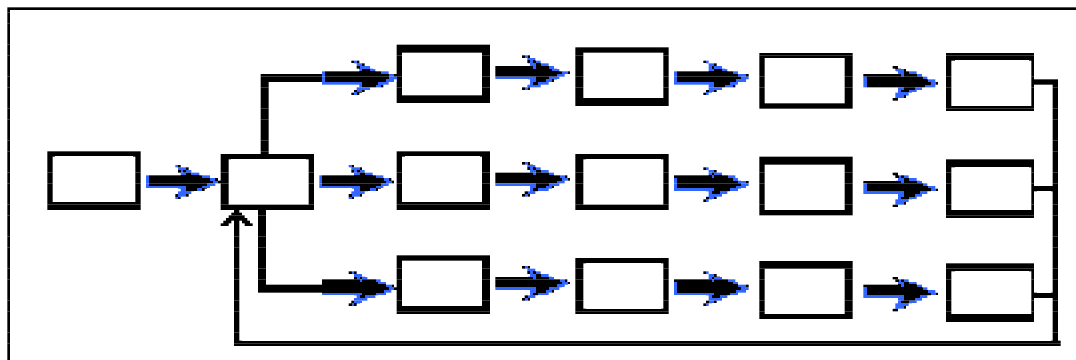
This digital media design is used extensively with digital storytelling. In this design, the user moves from the beginning to the end and has the choice to return to the beginning.

Two-Way Linear



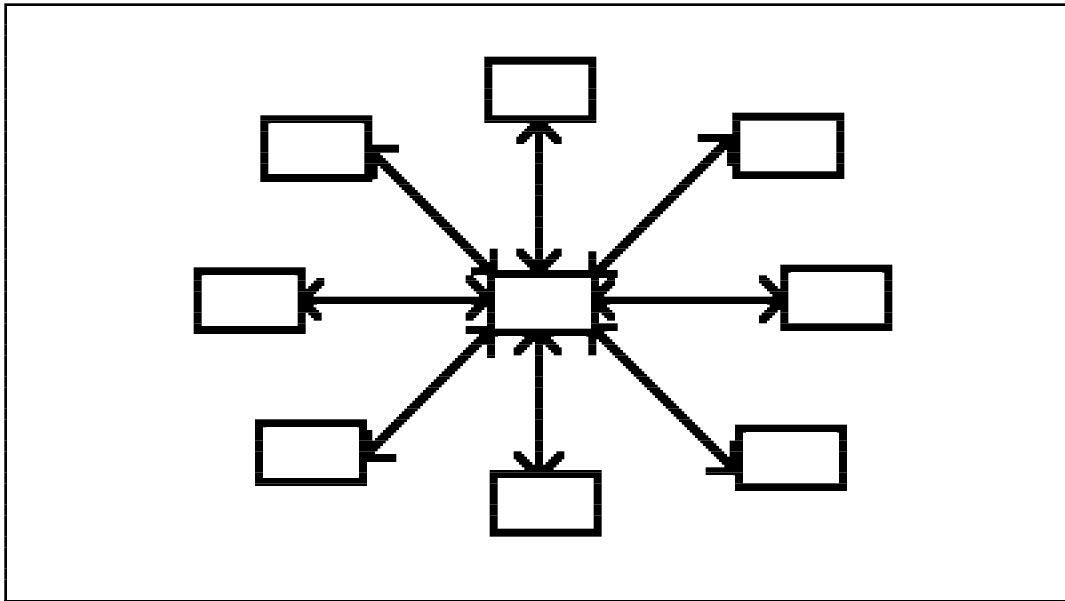
This digital media design has a similar concept to the Straight Line approach although the user has the choice to move forward or backward during the presentation.

Indexed Straight Line



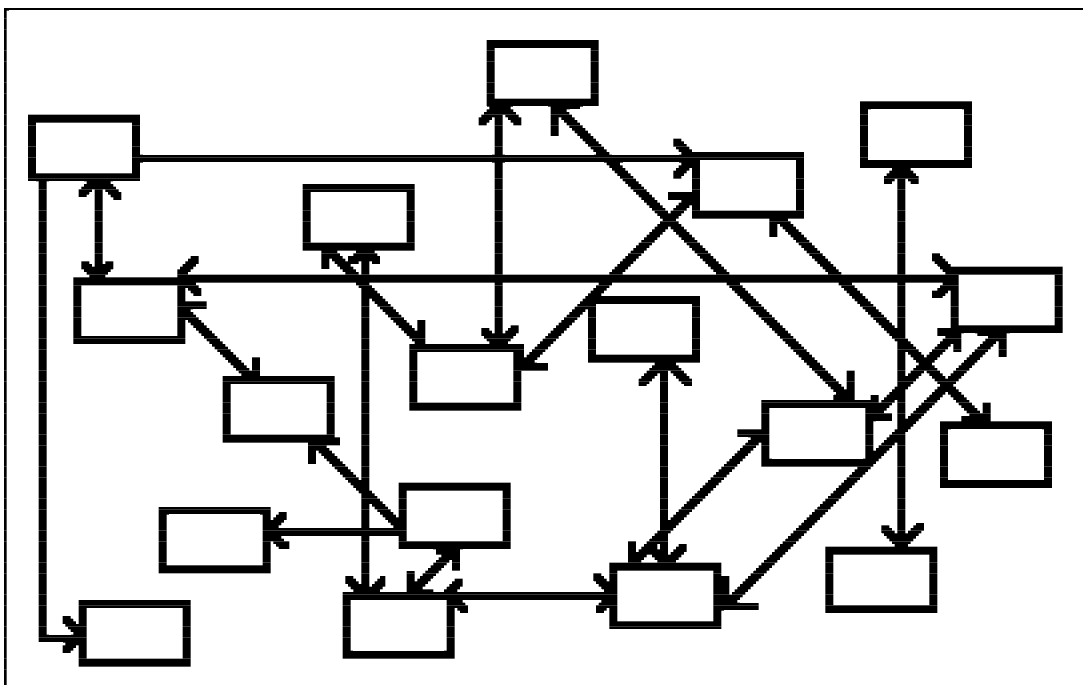
The Indexed Straight Line approach gives the user a sense of direction from the beginning with a table of contents or menu to choose from. Once the choice has been made, the user can select a linear path and finish a topic, return to the beginning and take another path of information.

Spoke



The Spoke design is one of the most common used pages in web design and digital media projects. This navigation design allows the user to begin at a common starting point or hub. From the hub the user may visit any subcategory, with the option of always returning to the hub for another choice.

Controlled Chaos



This approach is one of the most effective for navigation but can be one of the most difficult. From this design, the user is able to visit nearly every page or area of the project from any other page in the project.
